Shepherd's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings. I need to warn you that I've been removed from ministry from the Niagara hospitals. I was told that I am "not in compliance" regarding the vaccine mandates (by those who value such things) and that no discussion was possible. What this means for you, practically speaking, is this: put me down as a 'family member' and then I will be able to visit you.

I am resisting the mandates on purpose. Either we all stand up for every freedom or we will all lose them all, including religious freedom.
