

Who is the Man of Sorrows?!

Isaiah 52:13—53:12

13Behold my servant shall understand, he shall be exalted, and extolled, and shall be exceeding high. 14As many have been astonished at thee, **so shall his visage be inglorious among men**, and his form among the sons of men. 15He shall sprinkle many nations, kings shall shut their mouth at him: for they to whom it was not told of him, have seen: and they that heard not, have beheld. 1Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed? 2And he shall grow up as a tender plant before him, and as a root out of a thirsty ground: there is **no beauty in him**, nor comeliness: and we have seen him, and there was no sightliness, that we should be desirous of him: 3**Despised**, and the most abject of men, **a man of sorrows**, and acquainted with infirmity: and his look was as it were hidden and despised, whereupon **we esteemed him not**. 4Surely he hath borne our infirmities and carried our sorrows: and we have thought him **as it were a leper**, and as one struck by God and afflicted. 5But **he was wounded** for our iniquities, he was bruised for our sins: the chastisement of our peace was upon him, and **by his bruises** we are healed. 6All we like sheep have gone astray, every one hath turned aside into his own way: and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. 7He was offered because it was his own will, and he **opened not his mouth**: he shall be led as a **sheep to the slaughter**, and shall be dumb as a lamb before his shearer, and he shall not open his mouth. 8He was taken away from distress, and from judgment: who shall declare his generation? because **he is cut off** out of the land of the living: for the wickedness of my people have I struck him. 9And he shall give the ungodly for his burial, and the rich for his death: because he hath **done no iniquity**, neither was there deceit in his mouth. 10And the Lord was pleased to bruise him in infirmity: if he shall lay down his life for sin, he shall see a long-lived seed, and the will of the Lord shall be prosperous in his hand. 11Because his **soul hath laboured**, he shall see and be filled: by his knowledge shall this my just servant justify many, and he shall bear their iniquities. 12Therefore will I distribute to him very many, and he shall divide the spoils of the strong, because he hath delivered his soul unto death, and was **reputed with the wicked**: and he hath borne the sins of many, and hath prayed for the transgressors.
